This month we will be learning the letters, N, O, P, and Q. We will also exchange cards and talk about friendship for Valentine's Day.

For the letter N book page we will be making nests and filling them with numbers. The children will learn about different kinds of birds and their nests, talk about being nice and practicing counting and numeral recognition. We will play hopscotch on our little number rugs.



In our second week we will be studying the letter O. Some of our projects will include making string paintings with orange paint on cut out ovals, drawing night pictures of owls, and cutting out octagons.



During our third week of February we will talk about the letter P. We will talk

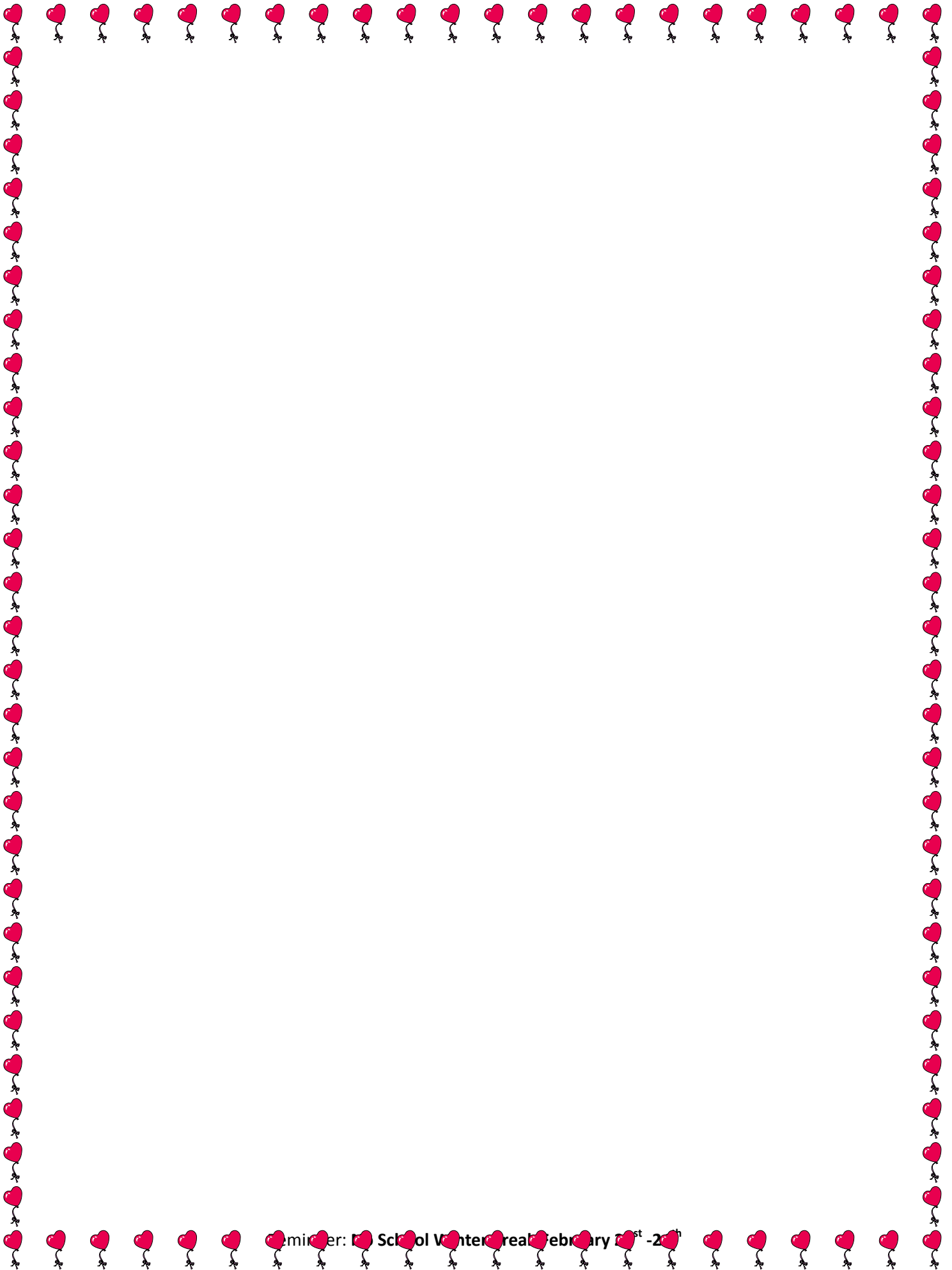
